August 28, 1963	March on Washington where Martin Luther King delivers “I Have a Dream” speech.
1968	Civil Rights Act outlaws discrimination in the sale or rental of housing.
1957	President Eisenhower sends U.S. Army to Little Rock, Arkansas to enforce desegregation of schools.
1909	National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) is formed
1954	Brown vs. Board of Education of Topeka, Kansas
1865	13 th Amendment outlaws slavery.
February 1, 1960	The launch of sit-ins that spread to 54 cities in 9 states.
December 1, 1955	Rosa Parks refuses to change seats on a Montgomery, Alabama bus.
August 6, 1965	The Voting Rights Bill becomes law.
