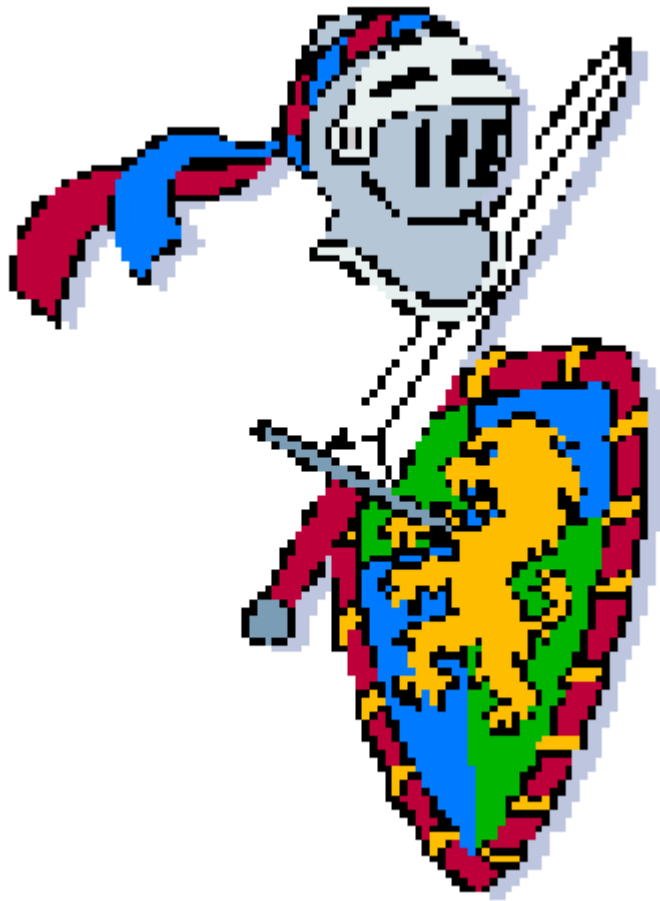


Coat of Arms

(Activity #3)

Each knight had a symbol that showed some event or personal quality in his life. This symbol (heraldic) was his coat of arms and was used to identify the knight. Only these seven colors were available for use on a coat of arms: blue, red, green, black, purple, gold, and silver. This symbol was placed on his shield, breastplate, helmet, tunic, or cloth covering his horse. Colors and symbols were carefully selected, as there could never be two alike.
