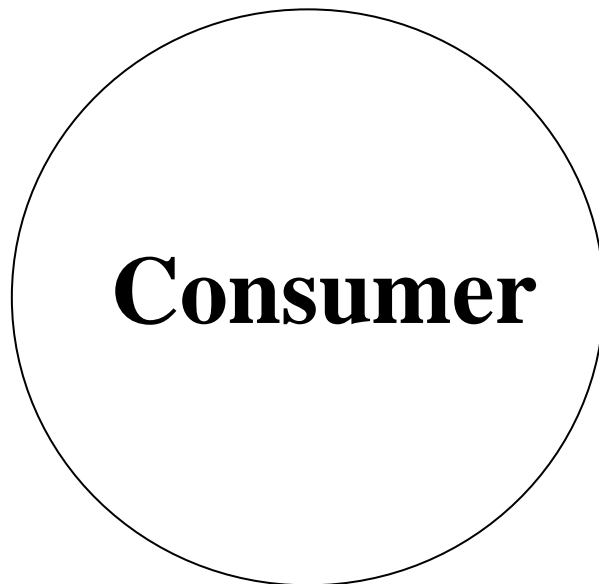
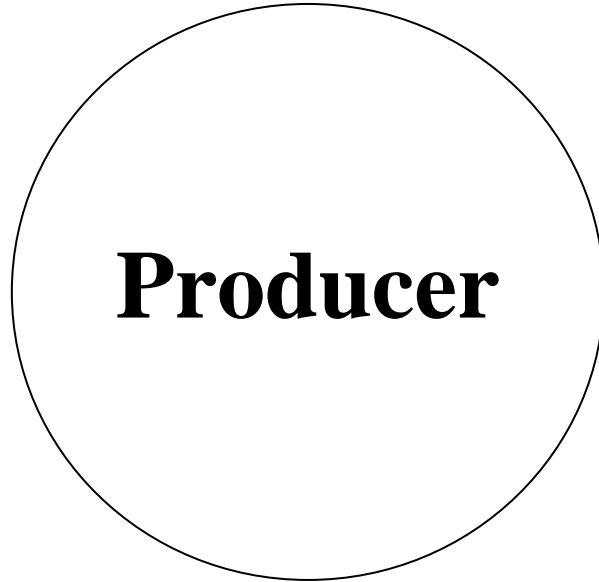


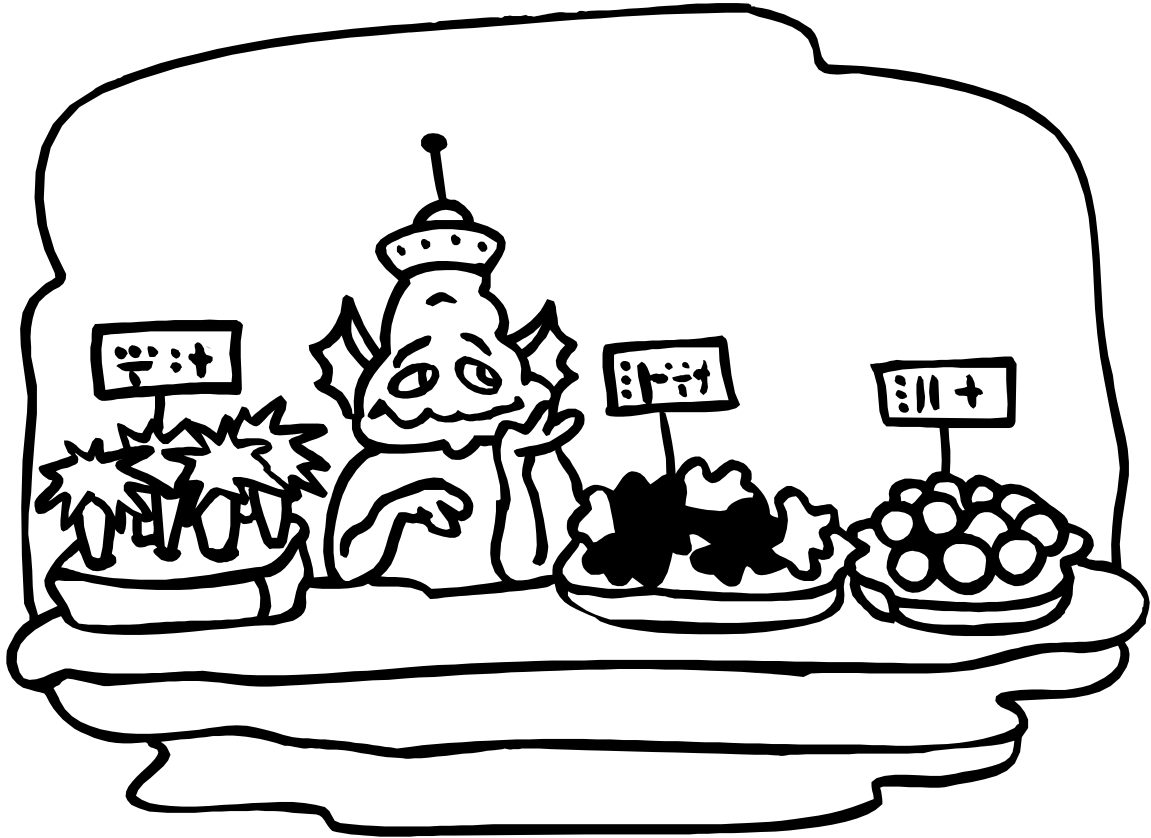
**Producer/Consumer Badges**

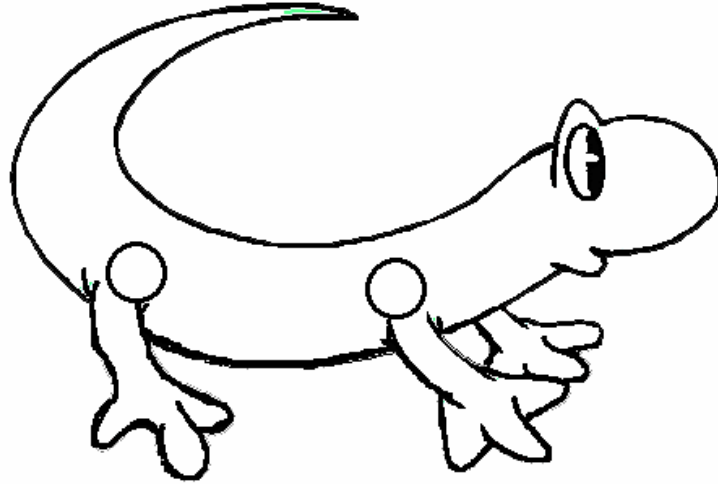

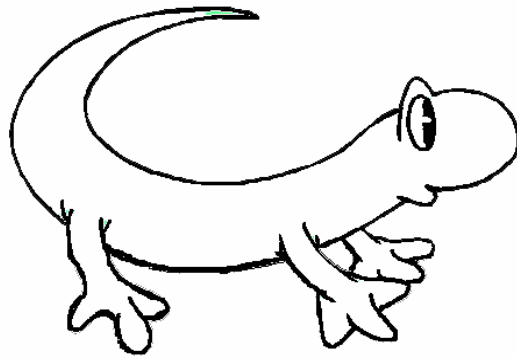

### Sample Eco Pencil Topper

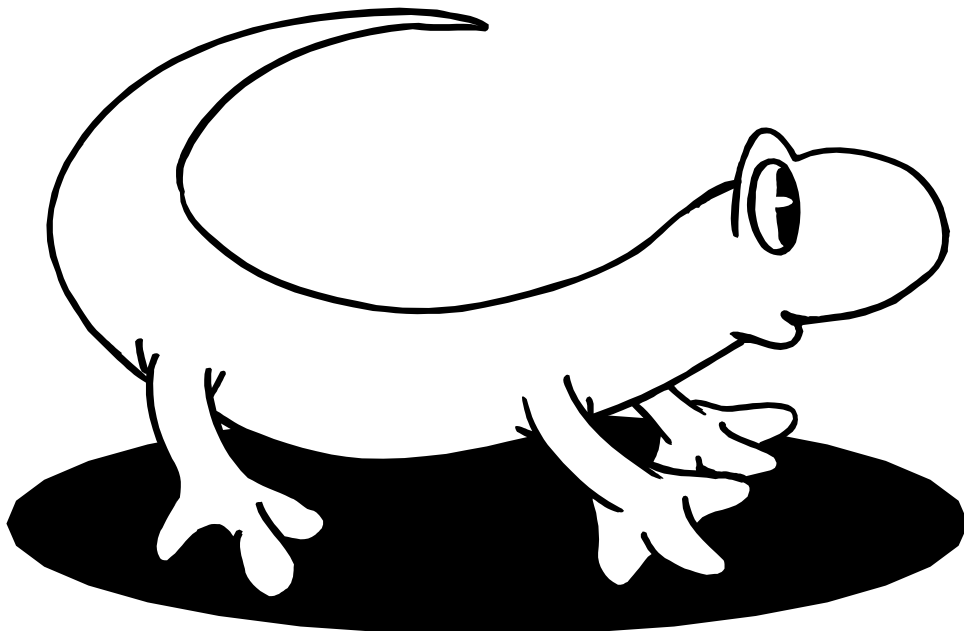

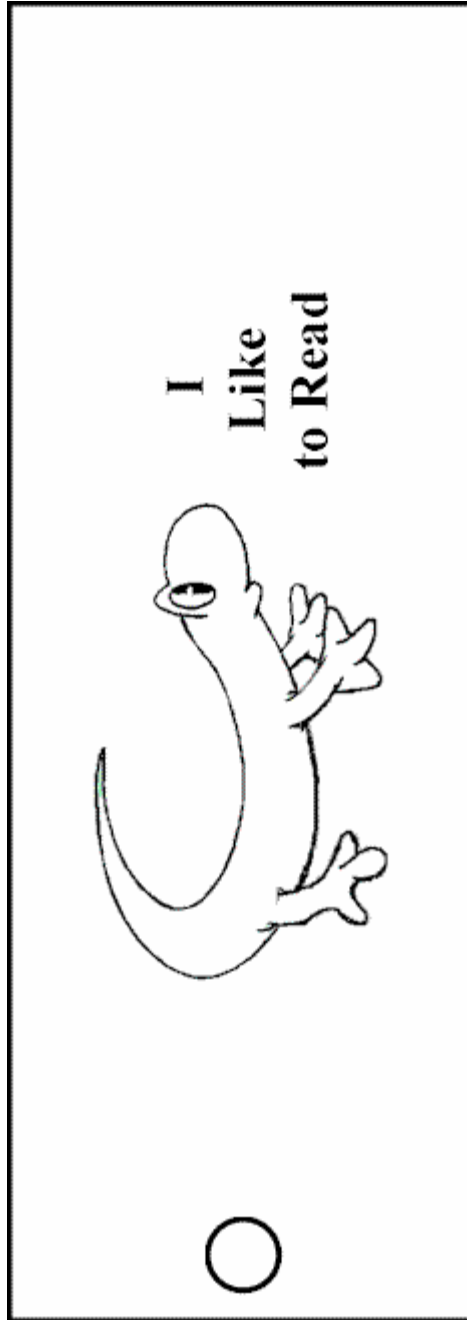
