Some village parts are inconsistent with historical sources and make it difficult for the observer to determine the region depicted.	Calculating and constructing to scale was attempted, but many errors are evident.	Some deficiencies in labeling are evident in the village and inconsistent with the region depicted.	Village exhibits a limited variety of material in construction.	Students worked well in a group some of the time, but completed the project according to the timeline.
1	Many village components may be inconsistent with the region depicted or not represented.	Village construction is inconsistent with historical sources and region depicted.	Buildings are of relative size, but there is no clear scale established.	Most of the village is labeled incorrectly, not labeled, or inconsistent with the region depicted.	Village exhibits primarily one type of material in construction.	Students eventually completed the project as a group.
