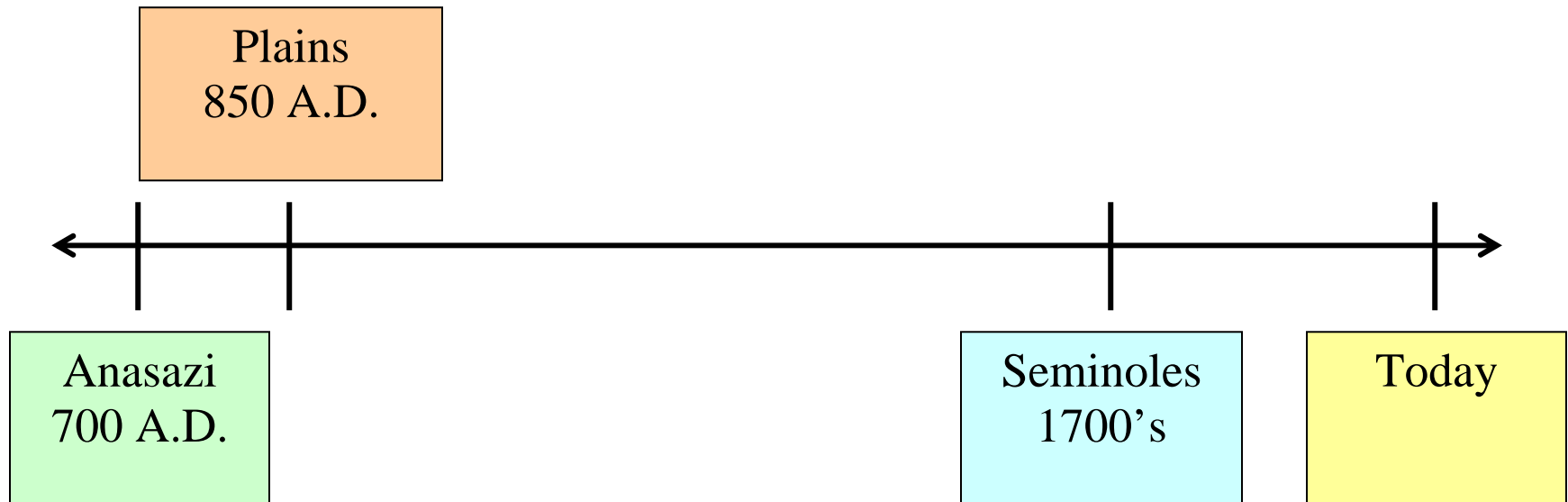

Center 1

Southwest Indians

- 1. Choose some pieces of Styrofoam.**
- 2. Use markers to draw brick shapes and openings on them.**
- 3. Break two short pieces of tree stems to make the steps for a ladder.**
- 4. Find two longer pieces of tree stems to make the sides of the ladder.**
- 5. Glue the shorter pieces to each of the longer pieces to make steps on a ladder.**
- 6. Look at the pictures of deserts in the center.**
- 7. Use the construction paper scraps to make plants and animals that live in a desert. Tape them around your adobe.**

Center 2

Southwest Indians

- 1. Pinch off pieces of your clay.**
- 2. Roll the pieces of clay into long ropes.**
- 3. Coil one of your ropes to make a flat, round bottom for your pot.**
- 4. Place another rope on the outside edge of the bottom of your pot.**
- 5. Wrap it around the outside edge.**
- 6. Add another rope of clay by pinching the ends together.**
- 7. Wrap it around the outside edge of the pot.**
- 8. Add more ropes of clay until your pot is as high as you want it.**
- 9. Use a Popsicle stick to smooth the sides and insides.**
- 10. Write your name on a piece of waxed paper.**
- 11. Place your finished pottery on it.**

Center 3

Southwest Indians

Planting Seeds

- 1. Find a clear, plastic cup with your name on it.**
- 2. Fill it halfway to the top with soil.**
- 3. Plant 2 or 3 corn seeds near the sides of the cup. Make sure they are covered with soil.**
- 4. Pour some water in the cup.**
- 5. Put your cup near the sunlight.**

Corn Cycle Worksheet

- 1. Write your name on your paper.**
- 2. Cut out the pictures at the bottom.**
- 3. Look at the pictures. Think about how your corn plants will grow.**
- 4. Glue the pictures at the top in the order you think your plants will grow.**
