## Instructions for Centers (Plains Indians)

### **Center 1 Plains Indians**

- 1.Look at the chart with Indian symbols.**
- 2.Using your crayons, copy some symbols onto your tepee. Try to tell a story with the symbols.**
- 3.Color the rest of the tepee.**
- 4.Cut out the tepee.**
- 5.Fold it into a cone shape and glue or tape the edges.**

## **Center 2**

### **Plains Indians**

- 1. Use the class map to help you.**
- 2. Open your map booklet to Activity Sheet 4.**
- 3. Write the name of today's region on the space at the top.**
- 4. Look at your map symbols.**
- 5. Cut out the symbols that go with the Plains region.**
- 6. Glue them in the three boxes in the middle of the page.**
- 7. Write one of the facts under "Fact".**
- 8. Finish the "And so" part.**

## **Center 3**

### **Plains Indians**

- 1. Get two paper plates.**
- 2. Turn them so the side you would not eat on is facing up.**
- 3. Use markers or crayons and make Indian symbols on the plates.**
- 4. Put one plate on top of the other and staple half way around the edge.**
- 5. Drop a handful of dried beans down in the plates.**
- 6. Staple the rest of the edges together.**
- 7. Glue streamers around the edges of the plates.**

## **Center 4 Plains Indians**

- 1. First, get a paper frame.**
- 2. Next, choose 5-6 paper strips you want to weave with.**
- 3. Begin by putting the end of one paper strip over then under through the strips on the frame.**
- 4. When you get the strip woven, put a dab of glue on the back of both ends and glue them to the frame.**
- 5. Weave the rest of your strips until the frame is filled up.**
