


Following the examples on this page, keep a log of your project and plan what else you will need.

Sample Assignment Sheet

Spanish II Technology Project
November 28, 2002

Date due: Friday, December 14, 2002

Working alone or with a partner, create a 1:30-2:30 minute Movie Works presentation.

Pretend that you are a real estate agent trying to sell a house to a distant buyer. Create a tour of the house and describe the rooms and features of the house.

Requirements:

- At least ONE video clip
- At least ONE scanned picture
- At least FOUR still pictures
- ONE text-over title page
- ONE text-over credit page
- BACKGROUND MUSIC. NO copyrighted music!!!!
- A VOICE-OVER track in SPANISH describing the scenes and encouraging the prospective buyer to buy your house. If there are two of you creating the project, BOTH of you MUST SPEAK on the voiceover.

We will have three class periods in the Media Center together. Thursday and Friday this week and another to be announced later. The final product is due on Friday, December 14, 2001.

Students may work at a Movie Works computers in shifts of 17 minutes. Other work may be done at other computers but only the Movie Works computers will construct the video finished product.

No copyrighted music is to be used. Use only the music that is in the computer for this project.

Burn your final product onto the CD that is provided for you.

Knowledge:

Comprehension:

Application:

What approach would you use to sell your house?

Analysis:

What motive is there for the buyer to select your house?

Synthesis:

Design a home that you think you could sell.

Evaluation:

Compare your project to the rubric and tell what grade you think your project warrants and why.
