

Directions for Reenactment

- Pick a leader.

House of Representatives = Speaker of the House

Senate = President of the Senate

- Leader reads bill and members vote.

Remember majority rules!!

- If group votes no, throw the bill away.
- If group votes yes, send the bill to the other house.
- Repeat the process with the bills from the other house.
- Give the bills that passed through both houses to the Governor (the teacher) to have the final vote.

Checklist

___ A bill is written by a member of the House of Representatives or the Senate.

___ The bill is discussed and must have a majority vote.

___ If the bill is passed in one house, it is sent to the other house.

___ The bill is discussed and must have a majority vote.

___ The bill that passed in both houses is sent to the governor.

___ If the governor signs the bill, it becomes law.

___ Any bill that was not passed in either house or by the governor is returned and may be rewritten.

Assessment Key:
