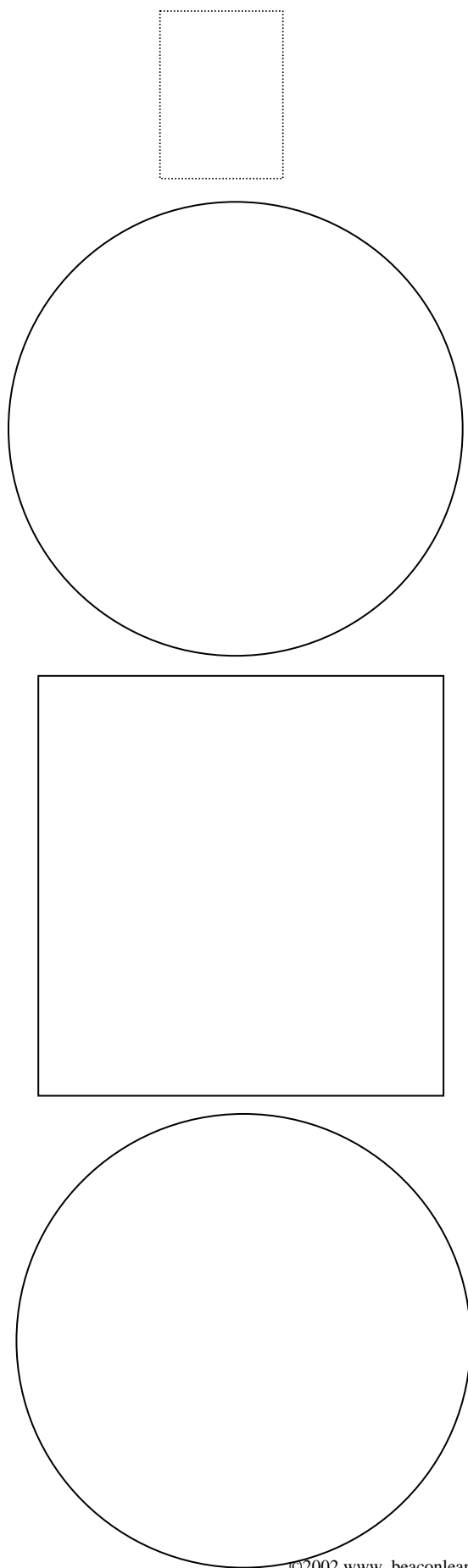
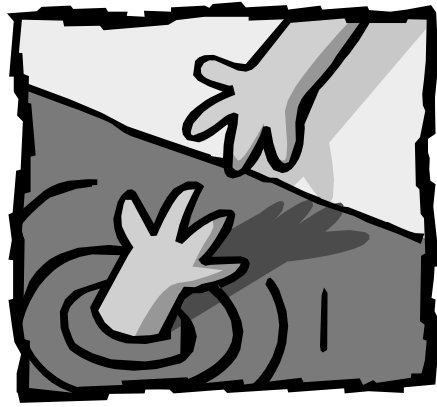


ABA Composition



Helpful Group Behaviors



Look at the person who is supposed to be talking.

Ask questions if you don't understand.

Get everyone involved.

Stay involved.

Give your opinion.

Ask others to give their opinions.

Include everyone in the group.

Listen when others are speaking.

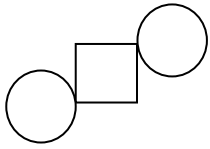
Check to see if everyone agrees.

Go along with the group's decision.

Accept apologies and move on.

ABA Composition



Criteria

The group should have 4 or 5 persons in it.

Every person has a performing part.

It has a steady beat all the way through on at least one instrument.

It has a beginning and an ending.

It shows ABA form.

The A sections are identical.

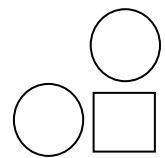
The B section is different than the A section.

The A and B sections have different sound sources.

Each section is at least 8 beats long.

Students may start over only once when performing for the class.

Students use any available sound source.
