Directions: Read each of the following scenarios carefully. Using the information given decide whether the person is a citizen of the U.S. or a non-citizen of the U.S. and on the short line under the scenario place a C for citizen or a NC for non-citizen. Explain your answer using the part of the scenario that you believed showed the persons status.

1. Your friend's father is from Egypt. He came to the United States 20 years ago and met his wife, your friend's mother. They have not left the United States in the time they knew each other. What is your friend's status? Explain your answer.

2. The owner of a real estate office speaks with a heavy German accent; he was born in Germany but has lived in the United States for 10 years. When you meet on Election Day, he had an -I voted- sticker. What is his status and why? Explain your answer.

3. You are introduced to your local representative to the Federal House of Representatives. What is his status? Explain your answer.

4. You are visiting the University of South Florida and you are introduced to Alice. Alice tells you that she is a junior at the university studying chemistry and enjoys the school very much. You ask if she will be back next year, but she says that her education visa will expire in July.
