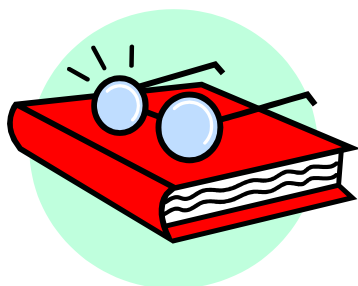

Instructions For How to Make a Pop-Up Book

Step 1 Take a sheet of paper and fold it bottom to top. Crease on the fold.

Step 2 Hold the paper by the crease and cut 2 parallel 1 inch lines from the top and bottom of the fold.

Step 3 Open the paper and push the newly formed tabs to the inside.

Step 4 Firmly pinch and pull the pop-up tabs from the inside.

Step 5 Close and press folds.

Step 6 Glue student made pictures or cut-out pictures to the tabs.

Step 7 Pages of a book are then glued back to back and covered with a title/cover page. (The first page is the only one glued to the front of the cover and the last page is the only one glued to the back cover).
