Student uses all of the elements of art (line, shape, space, contrast, texture, and color)	The student includes all six elements (line, shape, space, contrast, texture and color) in the picture. Student displays sufficient manipulative skills	The student manipulates the art materials skillfully and the observer can easily discern that they have mastered the manipulative skills of the materials.	The student displays basic manipulative skills of the art materials used to create their picture.	It is very obvious to the observer that the student does not use the materials with sufficient manipulative skills and the picture draws attention to the evidence of this rather than to the idea that is meant to be communicated.
Student communicates an idea from a poem.	The observer is easily able to correctly discern the idea the artist is communicating.	The observer is able to make a close guess, but may need more information to correctly discern the idea the artist is	The observer is not able to discern or make a close guess about what the artist is communicating.
