BEAUTIFUL HOMEMADE BUTTER IN A JAR!

INGREDIENTS:

- A PINT OF HEAVY WHIPPING CREAM
- A PINCH OF SALT
- A PEANUTBUTTER JAR WITH LID OR ANY UNBREAKABLE JAR WITH A LID.
- PLASTIC KNIVES
- SMALL PAPER PLATES
- STONE GROUND WHEAT CRACKERS.
- STUDENTS WHO LIKE TO SHAKE IT UP.

DIRECTIONS:

1. First pour the whipping cream into the jar.
2. Add the pinch of salt.
3. Have each child in each group take a turn shaking the jar for a minute or two. Explain to them the butter takes about 5 minutes of hard shaking before it forms.
4. The children will know the butter is ready when a lumpy ball begins to appear surrounded by a lumpy liquid. Pour off the liquid.
5. Spread a little bit of the homemade butter on some crackers and have the children enjoy.
