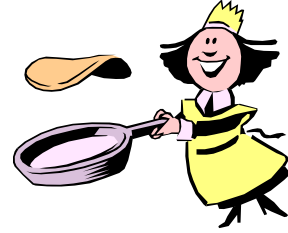

Steps for Making a Pictograph

1. List survey response items.
2. Choose a picture. Decide how many the picture represents.
Ex. 😊 = 2 people
Ex. Half a smiley face = 1 person
3. Draw pictures for each item based on the data collected.
4. Write a title above the graph.
5. Write what the picture means below the graph.
Ex. 😊 = 2 people
Ex. Half a smiley face = 1 person

Record their responses.

Survey Data:

Survey 2:

Survey Question: Which do you prefer to do before bedtime, read or watch television?

Survey Data:
10 students – Read
12 students – Watch television

Survey 3:

Survey Question: Which juice do you prefer, orange juice or apple juice?

Survey Data:
17 students – Orange juice
7 students – Apple juice
