Using Capital Letters Key

1. Write a sentence using a person's first and last name and telling about a place the person might go for supper.

Look for capital letters at the beginning of the sentence and at the beginning of the proper nouns. This sentence should contain two sets of proper nouns. One set is a person's name and the other set is the name of a restaurant.

2. Write a sentence that tells the name of the last movie or video you saw.

Look for capital letters at the beginning of the sentence and at the beginning of each important word of the movie title.

3. Write a sentence that tells the name of the last doctor you saw.

Look for capital letters at the beginning of the sentence and at the beginning of the doctor's title and name.

4. Write a sentence telling the last thing that your classmate said to you. Be sure use quotation marks and tell who was speaking.

Look for capital letters at the beginning of the sentence and at the beginning of the direct quote.

Note: Since punctuation was reviewed in a previous lesson, be sure to address any punctuation mistakes on this worksheet. Individual conferences can be used to assist students with punctuation errors.
